



We are hiring for Children's Program Teachers!

Children's Program teachers provide childcare for families attending Parenting Now groups. Children's Program teachers are on-site supervisors of the Children's Program when the Children's Program Coordinator is not present. May require some travel within Lane County.

Duties include:

- Responsible for the safety and well-being of attending children
- Present developmentally appropriate activities for children and use positive guidance to support their engagement
- Responsible for set-up and clean-up of room, activities, and snack
- Complete paperwork accurately and thoroughly
- Support Children's Program volunteers

Scheduling: Most groups run on weekday evenings or occasionally during the day. Teachers are typically assigned to 1-3 regular shifts per week depending on experience, interest and availability. Shifts consist of ½ hour of set up, 2 hours of childcare, and ½ hour of clean-up. Compensation is \$15.20/hour.

Qualifications: Must have a desire to interact with children, and be kind, caring, and compassionate. Criminal background check required for those 18 years and older.
