

FALL CRAFT

Here's a cozy, creative, and cost-effective fall craft idea that's perfect for families and practically free:

☐ Leaf Print Art on Recycled Paper Bags What You'll Need:

- Fallen leaves (variety of shapes and sizes)
- Brown paper grocery bags or scrap paper
- Washable paint (fall colors like red, orange, yellow, brown)
- Paintbrushes or sponges
- Optional: string or tape to hang the finished art

Instructions:

1. Go on a mini nature walk to collect leaves; this can be a fun bonding activity in itself.

- 2. Cut open paper grocery bags to create flat canvases.
- 3. Dip one side of each leaf into paint or use a brush to coat it lightly.
- 4. Press the leaf onto the paper to make a print. Repeat with different colors and leaf shapes.
- 5. Let them dry, then hang them up as seasonal decorations or turn them into greeting cards or placemats.

Why It's Great:

- Encourages outdoor exploration and creativity
- Uses materials most families already have
- Can be adapted for all ages
- Creates beautiful keepsakes or gifts

Affordable art materials like paints, paper, and more are available at MECCA (Materials Exchange Center for Community Arts) in Eugene. This nonprofit offers secondhand craft supplies at low or no cost - perfect for families, educators, and anyone looking to get creative without breaking the bank.
